

BALDWIN MAXWELL, born in Charlotte, North Carolina. Received the bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of North Carolina, the doctorate from the University of Chicago. Taught at Rice Institute and the University of Chicago, Professor of English and Chairman of the Department, University of Iowa. Visiting professor at the Universities of North Carolina, Chicago, Duke, Colorado, Northwestern, and Birmingham, England. Editor for many years of Philological Quarterly. Author of Studies in Beaumont, Fletcher and Massinger and Studies in the Shakespeare Apocrypha. First to hold the Foyle research fellowship in the Shakespeare Institute at Stratford-on-Avon, he has achieved distinction as a scholar in the Elizabethan drama.
