Irving Edward Carlyle, of Winston-Salem, alumnus of Wake Forest University and the University of Virginia Law School, achieved such wide recognition in the legal profession that he was chosen President of the North Carolina Bar Association. Like many other men of distinction in the State, he has generously used his talents in public service, as State Representative four terms and State Senator three terms, and twice as delegate to Democratic National Conventions. He has been a member of the North Carolina Budget Commission, the Board of Law Examiners, the State Board of Public Welfare, Chairman of the North Carolina Radio and Television Commission, and Chairman of the Governor's Commission on Education beyond the High School. This last typifies his interest in education, which is richly expressed through distinguished service as trustee of a college and two universities. He has long been a highly valued friend of the University of North Carolina, which takes pleasure in conferring on him the degree of Doctor of Laws.
