

Resolution 2018-2. On Amending the Faculty Code of University Government to Allow for Technical Corrections.

The General Faculty enacts that:

Section 1. The Faculty Code of University Government is amended by renumbering § 1-8 as § 1-9, and adding the following section:

§ 1-8 Technical Corrections.

The Committee on University Government may correct the language of this Code to update the names of units and the titles of officers to reflect changes made by the University. The Committee shall report such corrections to the Secretary of the Faculty and by him or her to the General Faculty.

Rationale: As the University develops and changes, names of programs and offices change. For example, the School of Journalism and Mass Communications is now The School of Media and Journalism. This proposed amendment allows the Committee on University Government to update names only. Without this amendment, to change a name specified in the Code requires an amendment to the Code approved by the General Faculty as specified in §1-7.
