Herman Glenn Baity, who has undergraduate and Master of Science degrees from this institution, and an earned Doctor of Science degree from Harvard, served the University well as teacher and administrator for more than thirty years. In 1950 he joined the World Health Organization, with headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland, where he held various important posts until his retirement.
