New LiveSafe safety app launched

LiveSafe turns smart phones into safety devices and provides discreet two-way communications with UNC public safety officials. LiveSafe is available to those who live and work on or near Carolina's campus, as well as their families and friends. The app allows users to call or message 911 quickly; report suspicious activity anonymously, through audio, photo or video messaging; and have a family member or friend virtually watch the user walk via the GPS-based SafeWalk feature.
