

Applied once other grants and scholarships are applied




Estimated cost: \$500,000 to \$600,000 from philanthropy. Estimated to cover unmet tuition and fees for 150-200 students per year.



Extends opportunity beyond other programs, such as the Carolina Covenant and Blue Sky Scholars, that provide tuition and fees to 5,000 undergraduates, with 3,600 in this income category.
