Committee Charge: According to <u>*The Faculty Code of University Government*</u>, the Faculty Hearings Committee is composed of nine faculty members with permanent tenure elected to serve three-year terms. The Committee performs functions assigned to it in the <u>*Trustee Policies and Regulations Governing*</u> <u>*Academic Tenure*</u>. Those duties include conducting hearings (a) on the request of a faculty member who has been notified before the end of his or her tenure or term of appointment that the University intends to suspend, demote, or discharge the faculty member; and (b) on the request of a faculty member for review of a decision not to reappoint him or her upon expiration of a probationary term of appointment.

New Matters Referred to the Committee in 2022-23:

- (1) The Committee received a request in January 2023 for a decision to discharge. The matter was sent to EOC before a hearing could be scheduled. In August we received this request again for a hearing following the conclusion of the EOC investigation. That hearing has been scheduled for December 2023.
- (2) In February 2023, the Committee received a request to grant a hearing for a denial of tenure and reappointment. The committee met in February and granted a hearing in this case. The matter was

then sent to EOC for an investigation. The case was returned to us in September for a hearing. Hearing was scheduled for Oct. 2023. Request was withdrawn before hearing took place.

New Matters Referred to the Committee in 2023-24 (as of November 1, 2023):

- (1) In August 2023, the Committee received a request for a hearing for a denial of tenure and reappointment following the conclusion of an EOC investigation. Hearing began on November 7 and was suspended while the case went back to EOC for investigation. The remainder of the hearing will be scheduled pending the outcome of EOC investigation.
- (2) In October 2023, the Committee received a request for a hearing on a decision to discharge. That hearing is being scheduled for January/February 2024.
