Resolution 2024-3. Amending *The Faculty Code of University Government* to increase the number of members on the Faculty Hearings Committee.

The General Faculty enacts:

Section 4-9 of *The Faculty Code of University Government* is amended as follows:

§ 4-9. Faculty Hearings Committee. (a) The Faculty Hearings Committee is composed of nine eleven faculty members elected by the voting faculty. Members must hold permanent tenure when elected. (b) The committee performs functions assigned to it in the Trustee Policies and Regulations Governing Academic Tenure. For each hearing, the committee's chair assigns members to a panel in conformance with the provisions of that document.

Justification

The proposed amendment would increase the elected membership of the Faculty Hearings Committee from nine members to eleven members, to increase the likelihood that enough members are available to serve when hearing panels are needed and to spread the workload more evenly among members when there are multiple hearings in a single term.
